I joined CrystalCommerce's team in 2011 as a somewhat experienced web designer. I later became the Design Team Lead as the team grew. Then, I found my niche as our team's first Frontend Developer (we now have 3).

My primary project has been improving our Point Of Sale, built with Backbone.js. I updated the UI with a responsive design (created by one of our graphic designers) and I have been adding new features (cash drawer management), incorporating client requests, improving the performance of the system, and fixing several legacy issues (i.e. syncing issues and killing "zombie views").

I also recently created a Wordpress plugin to embed CrystalCommerce products into our client's posts. It needed to work on a high traffic site and we needed it fast! Most of our more complex widgets were developed by me to meet common team (and client) needs. They combine Liquid logic (lol), jQuery, Ajax and CSS. Some examples include: an advanced menu widget to handle our client's oversized category tree menus, a "banner manager" with features like expiry dates and page targeting, and an Ajax cart preview widget that is populated via our new cart API and leverages easy-to-update Mustache templates.

Service Oasis's primary project, MusicTeachersNet.com, needed an experienced PHP/MySQL developer to expand their toolset to keep up with their business needs.

While keeping up with feature requests, I migrated their existing spaghetti code to an MVC architecture, removing thousands of lines of redundant code! I also created a CMS solution that fit their framework, giving them control over their previously static pages, improving the page routing, and added templating. Later, we purchased a zip-code database and I implemented nearest-match algorithms for instructor-to-student pairing logic. Other features included Ajax at-a-glance scheduling and availability tools, and I was even able to replace their spreadsheet-based billing with an online equivalent that pre-populated with data for them to review.
